For the meaning of the key phrase "Yesu Ni Wangu, Wa Uzima Wa Milele", the website <www.cthree.org> explains:

'Yesu ni wangu' means 'Jesus is mine' and 'uzima wa milele' means 'everlasting life'. In the Swahili Bible 'uzima wa milele' is translated as 'everlasting life'.

So the literal translation is; 'Jesus is mine, He is (the God of) everlasting life'. Others translate it as 'Jesus is mine, furthermore, for eternity'.
